

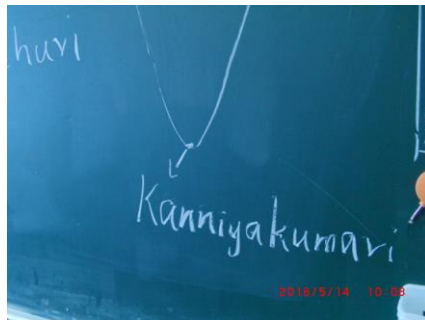
# Ms.Hannah, our Language & Culture teacher
